## **TYPE OF INSTITUTION**

## **PATTERN**

Gulf Coast High School operates on a modified 4X4 alternating day schedule that consists of four nine week sessions with four 86 minute classes per day. All classes meet five days per week. Students earn a total of eight credits during the school year. Students earn either a half credit per semester or a full credit for two semesters.
